New York Psychotherapy and Counseling Center (NYPCC)

NYPCC offers out-patient services in many communities including three outpatient Child and Family Clinics in Brooklyn and the Bronx. Their clinics are open 7 days a week at convenient hours. NYPCC's person-centered, episodic therapy and crisis intervention services are available for individuals and families, including children, adolescents and adults.

Same day appointments are available at all NYPCC clinics.

Case Management Services

Mercy Center

Free social services and case management are provided to individuals participating in Mercy Center programs who do not receive these services from other agencies. This is a time limited and goal/outcome oriented program that provides an opportunity for participants to work one-on-one with a case worker to solve current problems and create a support structure that will prevent problems from recurring.
